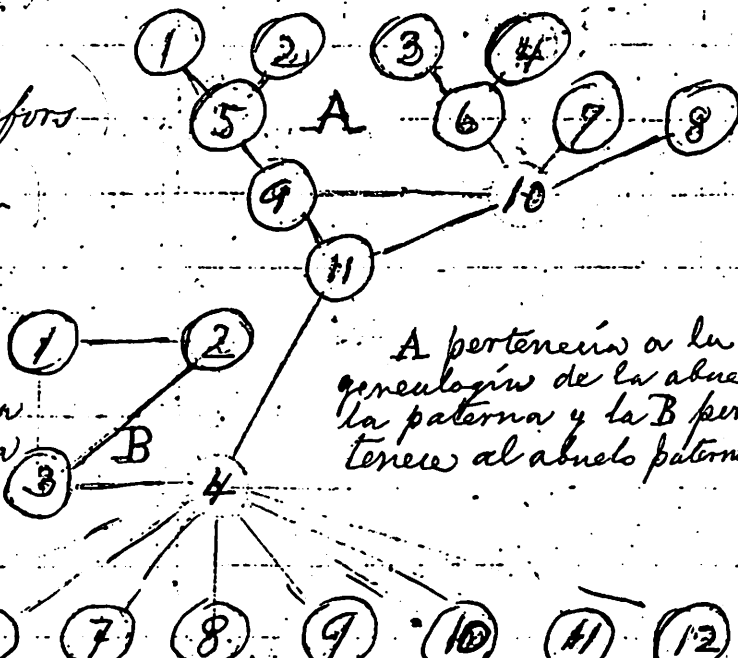

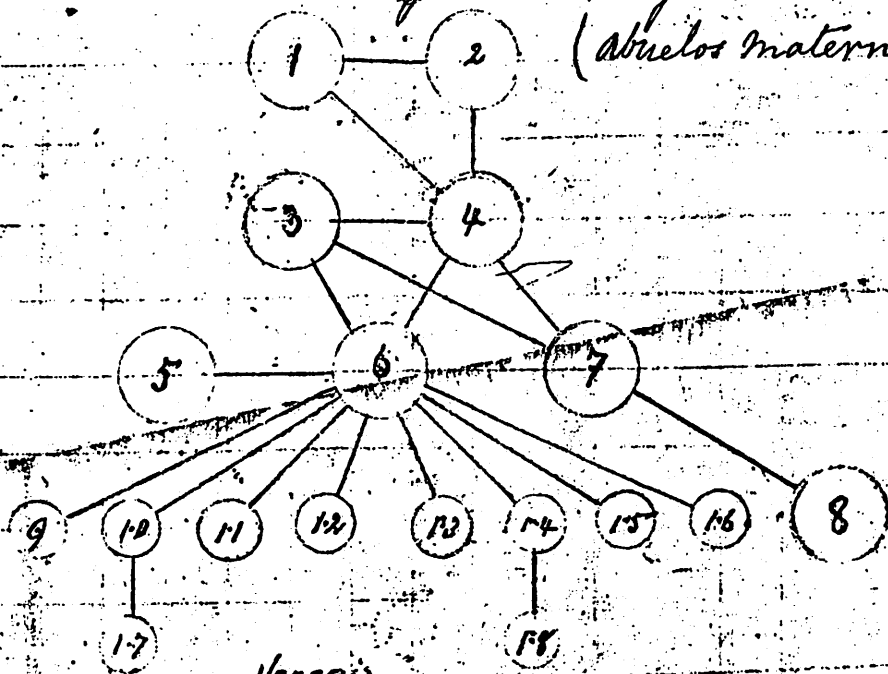

# The Italians in Colonial Florida - Bruno Roselli

**NICOLICH** or **NICODI**, *Nicolaus*, †, "de Ytalia", "Veneciae", "ex Venetia", "de Esclavonia", "ex parochia Lunne Venecie", "n.l de la parroquia de Lucin en Venecia". (1781, 1786, 1788, 1790, 1792, 1805, 1811, 1815).

Born ca. 1746 at Lussino in the Adriatic, the son of Martino and Maria (Terabossi) Nicolich; a sailor, who maintained a home and raised a family at St. Augustine. Was no longer living in 1811.

" *Josepha* (Coll), wife of Nicolaus. (1781, 1786, 1788, 1790, 1792, 1805, 1811, 1815). She had been married before, and a child by her first marriage was reported by Father Hassett in 1786 as living in the Nicolich home:

Josefa Femanias, born 1775.

From her marriage to Nicolaus Nicolich the issue was as follows:

- " - *Martin*, born 1784, as reported by Father Hassett.
- " - *Maria Nicolasa Josepha*, baptized in 1788 at St. Augustine. Married, 1st, Diego Dominguez of Estrémadura, by whom she had a daughter, Antonia Gregoria, in 1805; 2nd (in 1815) Don Alexandro Cuccurú, son of Don Daniel Cuccurú, "natural de Italia"; *q. v.*—In 1813 she stood godmother for Agustin Nicolas Espolée, Indian child "del pueblo de Tampa", illegitimate son of Espolée y Calloguée.
- " - *Rafaela Josefa Manuela*, baptized in 1790 at St. Augustine.
- " - *Manuela Christoval Josepha*, baptized in 1792 at St. Augustine; married in 1811 Ramon Rogers.

**OLIVA**, *Martino Joseph Antonio*. "Non legitimus". Baptized at Father Camps' chapel near St. Augustine in 1778.

**OLIVER** or **OLIVERES**, of Corsica, see **OLIVIERI**.

**OLIVIERI**, *Sebastian*, †, "natural de Corsega", "de la Ysla de Corcega", "natural de Bonifacio en la Isla de Corsega". (1795, 1798, 1800, 1805). Son of Bartolommeo and Vincenza (Berti) Olivieri; lived in St. Augustine, where he had arrived long after the other Corsicans—with whom, as a native of Bonifacio, he would not be likely to associate. " *Caterina* (Alcina), wife of Sebastian. (1795, 1798, 1800, 1805).

ISSUE:

- " - *Vincenza*, born 1796. Died 1798.
- " - *Bartolomé*, born 1800.
- " - *Antonio Lorenzo*, born 1805.

**ORSI**, *Barbara Margherita*, †, "natural de Venecia en Ytalia". Born 1772 at Venice, the daughter of Joseph and Lucia (Gori) Orsi; married Don Juan Jacobo Souncillan. She died at St. Augustine in 1822, shortly after its cession to the United States. She was then a widow.

[33] Bonifacio, on the Straits by the same name separating Corsica from Sardinia, is inhabited by descendants of Genoese who were imported there after the town capitulated to the Republic of Genoa. The Bonifacini have nothing in common with other Corsicans; their dialect is Ligurian instead of Tuscan.
